It would normally take a crew of roughly fifteen experienced men almost two full days to unload the cargo from just one of these ships. Samuel Adams figures that, with 90 men split between the boats, they can unload all the tea in a matter of hours. It's bold, it's ambitious, and above all, it's risky.

Doc Warren is concerned about the inherent dangers of the plan.

-then how do we know the British won't come directly after us?

SAMUEL ADAMS

They won't.

WARREN

How can you be so sure?

SAMUEL ADAMS

Because. We'll be somewhere else.

The others - confused all turn to samuel Adams.

INT. EDES AND GILL PRINT SHOP - MORNING

CU: a hammer is tacking a FLIER to a post - the flier reads: "URGENT MEETING FOR ALL THOSE WHO DETEST THE EAST INDIA TEA COMPANY - COME TO THE MEETING HOUSE ON DECEMBER 16TH..."

REVEAL: Doc Warren is hammering the flier to the post.

TITLE: DECEMBER 10th - SIX DAYS UNTIL THE DEADLINE

VO

IN ORDER TO CONCEAL THEIR CONNECTION TO THE RAID, THE SONS OF LIBERTY ANNOUNCE A MEETING...

Warren turns to Paul Revere, handing off a stack of fliers.

Paul Revere shoves the fliers into his saddlebag, opens the door, looks up and down the street to make sure the coast is clear, then exits the print shop.
